Motion carried – Carl Long, Aye, JoAnn Hale, Aye



New Business: Carl has been getting a lot of calls on dogs running around Town, one in particular, Gus, we might need to raise the fine


Cottingham turning off of Main Street is getting hard to turn on because of cars parked on each side of the street
