They are going to put 2 lights East of the two-lane and upon completion there will be 2 additional lights installed. He thinks within 2 months the first 2 lights will be installed. John requested additional questions to be emailed to him that he can pass along to Mr. January. He will work on setting up a meeting.

**ARPA Fund Uses:** We were able to claim ARPA Funds as lost revenue which can then be spent on governmental expenses. These funds all need to be allocated by December 2024. Need to have a planning session at some point to discuss uses of these funds especially if we get the OWRB funds.

**Future Resolutions:** When we received training from OMAG we started a Resolution book. There are several resolutions that have been discussed that we can add to this book.

**Spring Event:** Had the Spring Fling at the park on the 6<sup>th</sup>. Raised some money for Fireworks show and the Firehouse Christmas event. Had a little lower turn out than we were hoping for, but still had a successful event.

**Fire Dept Report:** Been pretty slow, had 14 calls. Dinner is April 27<sup>th</sup>, BBQ Dinner and Dessert Auction. Since Logan Tax was passed, some trucks are getting repaired. The new reporting software should be up and running soon.

**Financial Report:** Current balance as of 3/31/24  
General Fund: 51,127.91  
CPWA: 103,472.64, minus bond payments, 72,472.64  
Coyle Fire Department: 51,960.66

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A Monthly Cash Activity and Balances Report and a Budget to Actuals comparison as of March 31, 2024 were also provided.

Have started the budget process and would like to schedule a budget workshop towards the end of the month to go over budget items.

- Maintenance Report:** Picked up Spartan and parts from Beck's. Mowed memorial park, depot, museum, and ball parks with the Kabota. Several things loose on the Spartan including a broken weld that keeps the blades from going forward.
- Cemetery Report:** Nothing to report. Set a date to go out to the cemetery to clean it up and mow out at the cemetery. Date set for the following weekend to work on cleanup at the cemetery.
- Court Clerk/Code Enforcement Report:** Courtesy Notices were sent as discussed in the Special Meeting. Spoke with Judge Kirk and court will be held on the first Tuesday of the month at 6:00pm. A list of court dates was provided.
- Old Speeding Tickets:** We have a lot of old tickets that are flagging when people are trying to renew their licenses now, some 20-30 years old. If decided to dismiss them, they wouldn't owe the Town any money, but would still have to clear it up with the state.

- Next Meeting:** Next meeting is scheduled for May 14, 2024

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
