Water Report: Checked meters this month. Have had no leaks. Need to fix meter on Pulliam next week, not reading anything. Found a meter and gaskets to replace. Fence around water tower needs to be 6 ft tall with 3 rows of barb wire on the top. Needs to be big enough to get at least a mower inside the fence. Possibly a double gate as well as a walk-in gate. Need to figure out how far away from the tower it needs to be. Once we get lagoon and lift station taken care of, would like to get more water pressure. Adding on to the water tower would give more pressure. Do we need to check hydrants to see which ones are functional? Needs to be done during the summer when the kids are not in school. Some

Terry Haws from Republic:

Terry Haws was not at the meeting. JoAnn would like to discuss the containers with Republic. They would like to change our pick-up date to Tuesday. Bulk pickup didn't get finished on Friday, finished on Monday. Town Council was very disappointed that he was unable to attend and didn't let us know. Would like to meet him and form a relationship with them. Can they change the date per the contract? Carl spoke with people in town and they would prefer the Tuesday pickup because its after the weekend. We shouldn't be billing to anyone outside of our city limits.

CPWA Truck Quote:

If we could buy all the parts ourselves and have them fix it, it would significantly knock down the price. Could just use regular valve stems instead of the tire sensor gauge. Will they put on the parts if we buy them? They upcharge the price just like dealerships. Some things can be done by us, some things need to be done at the shop. Also need to request not the highest priced parts.

ORWA Membership:

If we had a big leak and needed help, they can come help us. Also have a wastewater person that can come out and help us with our wastewater system. Cost is \$252.00 for the annual membership.
