- Financial Report:** Account Balances as of 1/31/2023:
General Fund: \$98,247.37, less the ARPA money: \$65,453.31
CPWA: \$53,942.10
Coyle Fire Department: \$47,254.64
We have not been getting our motor vehicle taxes due to the fact that we are out of compliance because of our audits. We can now run reports and compare budget to actuals. The roof on the depot has been budgeted for, however no work toward to that has been done.
- Maintenance Report:** Still working on getting bids for carpet for the office. Kevin is clearing off 3 feet from the road on north Iowa. The dip at Cottingham and Main Street needs attention. We may need to rent a milling machine to help correct this issue. May speak to county commissioner to see if they can help us with this.
- Cemetery Report:** Nothing to report.
- Court Clerk Report:** Nothing to report.
- Adopting State Statutes:** Need to adopt these so we can get our judge going again. JoAnn asked Wade if he would still be willing to be the code enforcer. After the spring cleanup and reaching out to churches and the school to help with cleanup before he would issue ordinance violations. By adopting these, it will allow us to force the properties that aren't being cleaned up to a sheriff sale with the hopes that other people will purchase and take care of the property.


